



Dayspring Ranch Open 2019 Players Handbook

General Property Notes

- PDGA Rules are enforced
- All Out of Bounds are marked with white paint with or without white flags
- All fence lines are out of bounds with the exception of details in Course Notes below. Free drop to all stances, swings that are affected by fences. 2 meters.
- There is poison oak off the fairway on holes 5,11,12,13. Free drop from these areas unless marked OB.
- U-Disc has been updated with the tournament layout and distances. Use it when in doubt to find the next tee, basket or distance.
- Watch for poison oak and tripping hazards. Play at your own risk.
- Junior tees will be marked with Blue flags.
- Drop Zones will be marked with Red flags.
- Most players prefer wearing light pants or some shoes with a higher ankle on them to prevent the fox tails getting in their shoes.
- Please, NO SMOKING on the course. There is fire danger.

Course Notes

1. Hole #1 OB on left along the creek and behind the basket. OB right fence line.

2. Hole #2 OB on right. Round pen on left is in play. Play as it lies.
3. Hole #3 OB on right and behind basket.
4. Hole #4 Dogleg right. Tee is OB. Over the creek is in bounds. The creek runs from in front of the tee and to the right along the fairways right side. Drop zone for missed tee shots will be over the bridge and to the right.
5. Hole #5 OB is the creek on the right but really should not come into play. Straight off the tee there is a large patch of Poison Oak that has been sprayed is marked OB around it. OB left of basket separating holes 5 and 18 approximately 50' left of the basket.
6. Hole #6 OB on the right around some blackberry patches outside the fairway.
7. Hole #7 OB Fence line behind the basket. Mando left of the power pole. Drop zone will be marked near the pole.
8. Hole #8 OB Fence on the right and behind the basket. OB left separating fairways 8 and 9 approximately 250 to 400 ft from tee.
9. Hole #9 OB Left separating fairways 8 and 9 approximately 150 to 350 ft. from tee.
10. Hole #10 No OB
11. Hole #11 Dogleg right to left past the large pine tree. OB on the right side 300' from tee separating holes 11 and 9. OB long at the corner of the dogleg. Large patch of Poison Oak.
12. Hole #12 Dogleg right. No OB. Place your shot right and you can get a look at the blue basket in the trees. Watch your step. Putter like throw for next tee shot in case you want to leave your bag or cart climbing this hill.
13. Hole #13 Island hole with drop zone. 100' past the basket is safe but not much room in front of the basket.
14. Hole #14 Mando right with drop zone.
15. Hole #15 No OB.
16. Hole #16 OB right along the lowest part of the valley. OB left at the right side of the road. All log piles are a free drop no closer to the basket. Please use caution in and around these areas.

17. Hole #17 No OB.

18. Hole #18 Long Dogleg right. Tee is OB. Fence line begins in play boundary. Distance to clear fence is 250 ft. Drop zone for missed tee shots. OB left separating holes 5 and 18 of approximately 250 to 450 from tee. OB deep behind the creek separating holes 1 and 18. OB fence line on right all along the fairway. Walking from the tee please walk to the left of fence line to access the fairway.
